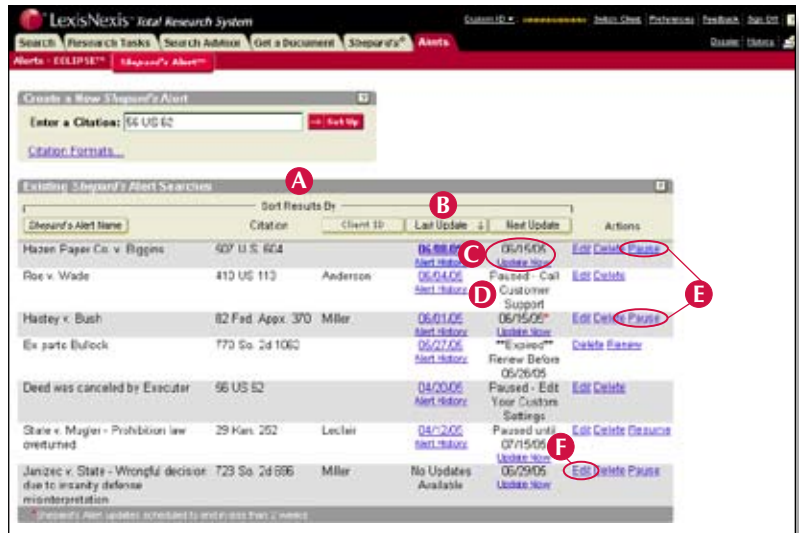

- The Alerts tab

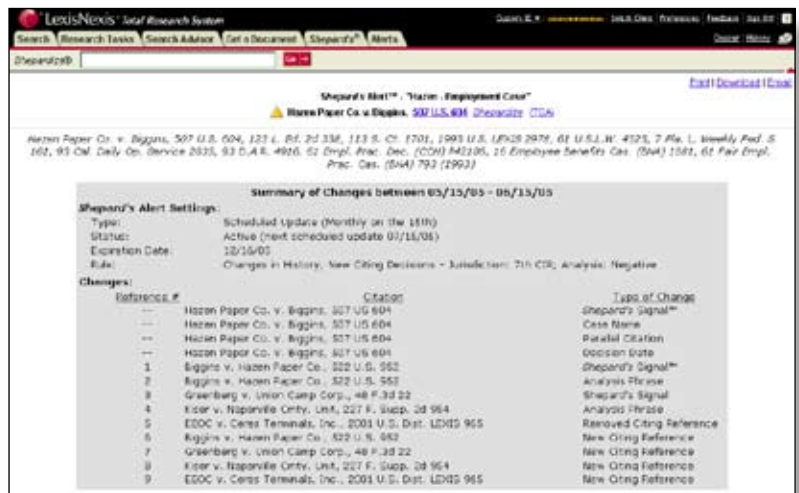
*Note: The Custom Settings form includes all the LexisNexis[®] headnotes for cases being monitored. Using the Custom Settings allows you to track only those changes that are of interest to you, e.g., only new citing references from a particular jurisdiction.

To view and change existing Shepard's Alert searches

After setting up one or more Shepard's Alert searches, you can view the results of existing searches as well as make changes.



- A** Sort your results in order of desired display.
- B** A date in bold type indicates an update has not been viewed or that there are changes to the Shepard's report.
- C** View a summary of changes for a report since the last update, or a comprehensive list of changes from the beginning date of the Shepard's Alert search until the most recently run update. A sample summary is shown in the second screen displayed to the right.
- D** Updates halted because of End Date.
- E** Pause a Shepard's Alert search if you're going to be away for an extended period, e.g., on a business trip, then resume updates when you want to receive them again.
- F** Edit Shepard's Alert search settings.
